#### Jan. 6

Deadline for the Department Chair to meet with the candidate and inform the candidate of the recommendation for promotion, tenure, or both. The Chair shares with the candidate his or her written recommendation for or against tenure/promotion and gives the candidate a copy this report, as well as of the Notification form.

\* Candidates for tenure and/or promotion have one week from the time of the meeting with the Chair to include any additional materials supporting his/her candidacy by sending them as a PDF to the Dean.

#### Jan. 13

Deadline to submit all review materials, including Department Chair's recommendation(s) and completed and signed Promotion and Tenure Recommendation and "Departmental Review Notification" form to the Dean's Office.

#### Mid-Probationary Review Deadline

Reviews are due with your evaluation by **Friday, March 10, 2023.** You must have met with the candidate to discuss the results of the Departmental and Chair reports by this date.

Chairs set the candidate's and department committee's MP deadlines.
